

RULES TO LIVE BY

Avoid these common accidents between motor vehicles and slow moving vehicles.



Rear-end Collision

A motor vehicle approaches too fast and hits a slow moving vehicle. Consider that a vehicle traveling 55 mph catches up to one traveling 15 mph that's 400 feet away in just 7 seconds.

Left Turn Collision

A motor vehicle crashes into a slow moving vehicle as it's attempting to make a turn left.

Head-on Collision

A motor vehicle collides into a slow moving vehicle traveling in the opposite direction.
